This presentation is an out-of-this-world exploration of space and the solar system that includes A PLACE FOR PLUTO read aloud, discussion of belonging and following your dreams, along with a Q&A session. (Ages Pre-K-5th grade)

Q & U CALL IT QUILTS

PRESENTATIONS ON WORD PLAY, LETTER BLENDS AND FRIENDSHIP

Kids will have Quite a good time exploring digraphs and letter blends and learning about the letter Q while exploring the details of friendship. Presentation also includes a Q & U CALL IT QUILTS read aloud, along with a Q&A session. (Ages Pre-K-5th grade)

BLENDING FACT & FICTION: A WRITING WORKSHOP

WRITE YOUR VERY OWN STORY WITH A MIXTURE OF FACT AND FICTION!

Learn how to blend humor, fact and fiction in this workshop style session. Participants will brainstorm concepts, learn story structure, and laugh out loud!. (45 min- 1 hour) (Ages 3rd-8th grade)

THE VERY LAST LEAF

PRESENTATIONS ON LEAVES, TREES, & FACING YOUR FEARS

An unbe-leaf-able presentation on the life process of a leaf, a read aloud of THE VERY LAST LEAF, and a discussion on dealing with anxiety and facing your fears, along with a Q&A session. (Ages Pre-K-5th grade)

VIRTUAL VISITS

Virtual presentations are 30 minutes, including a presentation, story time and a Q&A. Virtual author visits are held using the platform of the school's choosing.

IN-PERSON VISITS

Full day includes 3-4 visits, lunch with the author, and an extra story time for younger students if time allows.
